If the weather forecast is good, then we will continue to sell lollies on a Friday for 50p each.



Dear Mrs Harrison

I hope that this email finds you well and rested ready for the new term.

I attended the Chanctonbury music festival in May 23, and spoke about Kyaninga Child Development Centre (KCDC) which is a charity that I am now volunteering with in Uganda. I had previously worked for West Sussex in several schools as a SENDCo and using my experience I am supporting the charity with the building of a Centre of excellence for children with special needs and disability.

At the present time, children with special educational needs and disability (SEND) cannot access government schools.

KCDC has a strong belief that all children have a right to education and that disability should not prevent a child from attending school.

At the presentation, I spoke about raising money for a sustainable wheelchair that is built from bamboo and bicycle wheels which are both available in Uganda. The terrain is very uneven, and a great deal of research has gone into the specification and design.

I am pleased to share with you that during the Music festival evening, we raised £395, and this has funded two wheelchairs for children with cerebral palsy.



I'm writing to you to share this wonderful news and raise the profile of the charity. The school has now moved into a building in the town of Fort Portal and will continue to grow. Our aim is to build a Centre of excellence where families can come for initial assessment for their children and where teachers can come for training and advice; with the aim for more children with Special needs and disability attending school.

If you are interested in the charity and raising money for another wheelchair, walking aid or trampoline, please don't hesitate in contacting me. I would be more than happy to put an assembly together with a PowerPoint and some video footage.

Thank you again for your support. I would be grateful it you could let the parents and children know what their money has achieved.
