



Some of us will continue to learn our words from last week, whereas others will move onto the new spelling rules. We're flying through various rules that children have learnt throughout their time at SPS. Next week we'll cover: adding -ly suffix to words including words ending with 'c' – which is then -ally. I before E spelling rule and how to apply.</p>
<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>In Literacy, we will be dedicating more time to our grammar and punctuation knowledge during the run up to SATs. The children have been amazing with their learning so far and we are incredibly proud.</p> <p>This week in guided reading, we continue reading Brightstorm whilst also practising a variety of different question styles. Throughout this, we will focus on developing our VIPERS reading skills: <b>Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval, and Summary.</b></p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Last week in maths we started drawing triangles by measuring the the angles required to correctly draw the shape. We shall continue this on Monday whilst working through various other geometry problems.</p>
<p>Topic Focus: RE/ DT</p> 	<p>We have made a great start on our cardboard automaton creations. We shall continue with this next week as we put together our final touches.</p> <p>In RE we are continuing to look at the 'Big Question': "What would Jesus Do?" and think about how Jesus' teaching impact our daily lives.</p>
