Curriculum Area	We are learning to...
<p align="center"><b>Spelling</b></p> 	<p><b>Mr. De Marco/Miss Salmon's &amp; Mrs. Wetjen's groups:</b></p> <p>This week we will be hopefully learning a new set of spellings. Children will be practising their spellings daily and have a quick test on a Monday. We will be using these words in our handwriting practise sessions too.</p>
	<p>This week we be writing our final paragraph for our travel brochure on our chosen USA State. <p align="center"><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In maths we will be learning to calculate intervals between different times, both within the hour and greater than an hour. We will then be carrying out some data handling, thinking about how we can collect, organise and represent data.</p> <p>We will be starting to learn our 9 times table and related division facts. We will also continue to practise for the MTC Government times table test that is carried out for all year 4 children in June. We will understand what kind of world Jesus wanted by considering sacrifice; know what a parable is and why the story of the good Samaritan is important to Christians; and understand the importance of charity in Christian life.</p>
