




Some of us will continue to learn our words from last week, whereas others will move onto the new spelling rules. We're flying through various rules that children have learnt throughout their time at SPS. This week we are covering – adding prefix dis-, words ending ible and able, words spelt with 'ous'.</p>
<p><b>Literacy</b></p> 	<p>In Literacy, we will be dedicating more time to our grammar and punctuation knowledge during the run up to SATs. The children have been amazing with their learning so far and we are incredibly proud.</p> <p>This week in guided reading, we continue reading Brightstorm whilst also practising a variety of different question styles. Throughout this, we will focus on developing our VIPERS reading skills:  <b>Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval, and Summary.</b></p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>We have finished our Y6 curriculum for Maths and for the next two weeks we are revising different maths concepts taught through the year. The topics we are revising: four operations word problems, multiplying and dividing fractions, fraction word problems, ratio and measure, fraction, decimal and percentage equivalence, angles, algebra, and repeating fractions.</p>
<p><b>Topic Focus: RE/ DT</b></p> 	<p>We are looking at our science block of light this week. We shall be conducting different experiments and learning about how light works. We are looking at how eyes capture light and send messages to the brain, shadows, refraction, mirrors.</p>
