




<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>This week in Literacy, we will be planting nasturtium seeds in our outdoor area! We will be working in partners to instruct them on how to do this by using imperative verbs (e.g. “grab”, “pick”, “poke”, etc.) and time connectives (“first”, “next”, “last”, etc.). Everyone will have the opportunity to plant their own. We will be recapping what we know about doubles and how once something is double, when we work backwards, they can be halved. We will explore what half means with shape by folding shapes before moving on to halving quantities. We will be saying these STEM sentences to support our understanding:</p> <p>The whole is split into _____ equal parts. There are _____ halves in a whole.
