



<p align="center">Spelling</p> 	<p>Mr. De Marco/Miss Salmon's & Mrs. Wetjen's groups:</p> <p>This week we will be hopefully learning a new set of spellings. Children will be practising their spellings daily and have a quick test on a Monday. We will be using these words in our handwriting practise sessions too.</p>

<p align="center">Maths</p> 	<p>In maths we will be learning to the language relating to turns. $\frac{1}{4}$ turn, $\frac{1}{2}$ turn, $\frac{3}{4}$ turn, clockwise and anti clockwise.</p> <p><u>The children all need to be practising telling the time at home including 24 hour clock, we would really appreciate your support with this!</u></p> <p>We will be starting to learn our 9 times table and related division facts. We will also continue to practise for the MTC Government times table test that is carried out for all year 4 children in June. <p align="center">Topic Focus: R.E</p> 	<p><u>We are continuing with our RE block this week.</u></p> <p>In R.E our theme is Gospel. We will understand what kind of world Jesus wanted by considering sacrifice; know what a parable is and why the story of the good Samaritan is important to Christians; and understand the importance of charity in Christian life.</p>
