


<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>Through a range of engaging activities, we will focus on writing clear sentences, using ambitious vocabulary, and organising ideas effectively. Pupils will also continue to develop their grammar and punctuation knowledge and application, including the use of capital letters, full stops, and conjunctions. Through shared and independent writing tasks, children will practise improving and editing their work.</p> <p>Please continue to encourage regular reading at home to support vocabulary development and build confidence in Literacy.</p> <p>Handwriting: We will be focusing on the following Ant words to join in cursive: money, Mr, Mrs, Christmas, parents If you have time, please support your child with this at home using the sheets they have completed.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths this week, we will be exploring time. We will learn to tell and understand o'clock and half past, quarter past and quarter to, as well as telling time past and to the hour. 

We use these words regularly in class. Even if your child is not currently in a spelling group, they can still practise them at home if you wish. These are the same words that will be sent home when children move through the individual spelling sets.
