


<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>In Literacy this week, the children will be writing a diary entry and an informal letter in the role of a character. They will focus on using interesting vocabulary, writing in the first person, and sharing thoughts and feelings clearly.</p> <p>Linked to Science, the children will also begin planning and planting their own sunflowers. We will be doing this earlier in the term so that the sunflowers have time to grow and develop before the end of the school year.</p> <p><b>Handwriting:</b></p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths this week, we will be continuing to develop the children's understanding of time. The children will learn to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes and use the language of "past" and "to". We will also explore how many minutes are in an hour and how many hours are in a day. 

We use these words regularly in class. Even if your child is not currently in a spelling group, they can still practise them at home if you wish. These are the same words that will be sent home when children move through the individual spelling sets.
