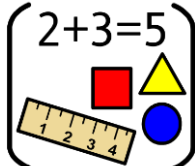


Stepping CofE Primary School: Weekly information for Parents and Carers

Curriculum Area	We are learning to...
Spelling 	Mr. De Marco/Miss Salmon's & Mrs. Wetjen's groups: This week we will be hopefully learning a new set of spellings. Children will be practising their spellings daily and have a quick test on a Monday. We will be using these words in our handwriting practise sessions too. Keep up the great work Year 4!
