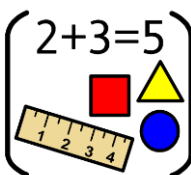
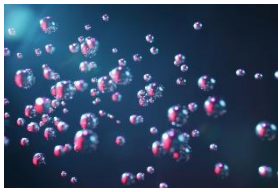


Steyping CofE Primary School: Weekly information for Parents and Carers

Curriculum Area	We are learning to...
Spelling 	Mr. De Marco/Miss Salmon's & Mrs. Wetjen's groups: This week we will be hopefully learning a new set of spellings. Children will be practising their spellings daily and have a quick test on a Monday. We will be using these words in our handwriting practise sessions too.
	In literacy we will be editing, polishing and presenting our fantastic traditional folktales that we worked hard on last week. These stories have a main animal character that faces a challenge, leading to growth and change. The stories have a clear lesson or moral at the end. Maths 	In maths this week we will be completing our assessment work. We will then be looking at measure with a focus on how to convert different units of length e.g. cm into m and vice versa.
Topic Focus: Science 	In science we will be continuing to learn about States of Matter. Last week we learned about how gas does have a mass with our fizzy drink investigation. Ask your children which was the fizziest and how we found that out! We will carry out further investigations looking at how particles can change state when heated and cooled by different amounts.
